Grants - we have recently been awarded a 3-year grant from two different organisations who have seen the value of what we do. This is really helpful and enables us to confidently move forward, providing a consistent offer to our Participants.

We still aim for 50% of our funding to come from **regular giving** and the other 50% from grants, as this makes us less grant dependent and also provides a way for people to become a part of what ReSkilled offers. So often we see needs and don't know how to realistically help - this is one way.
